### SERMON NOTES

#### *“The First Angel’s Message”*

Revelation 14:6-7

- I. “Having the Everlasting Gospel” —verse 6.
- II. “Fear God”—verse 7.  
“The fear of the Lord is that reverent attitude compounded of love, awe and gratitude that distinguishes men who have realized their own unworthiness and have found salvation in God’s gracious plan.” SDA Bible Commentary, I John 4:18.
- III. “Give Glory to Him”—verse 7.  
“Glory—in Biblical literature a term that expresses two general concepts: 1) ‘Honor’, ‘praise’, ‘esteem’, and those distinctive qualities that bring honor or excite admiration; 2) ‘Brilliance’ that emanates from or surrounds a radiant being or object.” SDA Bible Commentary, Volume 8, page 404
- IV. “For the Hour of His Judgment is come”—verse 7.
  1. Romans 3:23—God does not have to organize a judgment to condemn man—man is already condemned.
  2. John 3:16-18—Man further condemns himself when he rejects Jesus.
  3. Psalm 35:23-24—Vindication is another word for judgment.
  4. 1 Peter 4:17—The judgment or vindication starts with the righteous.
  5. Psalm 51:1-4—Our repentance justifies God in saving us. Romans 3:26.
  6. Ephesians 2:4-6—We have been placed in heavenly places now.
  7. John 14:1-3—Jesus is now legally securing in front of the universe our place in heaven for all eternity. John 1:12. Judgment is about God’s vindication of my vindication.
- V. “Worship Him that made...”—verse 7.
