SERMON NOTES "Who Will Open the Book?"

1. Who are the 24 elders?

- a. Sinners who have been redeemed. Revelation 5:9
- b. They were among the resurrected with Christ. Matthew 27:52,53, Ephesians 4:8.
- c. When Jesus was installed as our High Priest, He was anointed with the oil of gladness above "His fellows." Hebrews 1:9 These would be men not angels and would be priests.
- 2. Who or what are the four beasts?
 - a. Similar imagery used in Ezekiel 1:5-14
 - b. Commentators for centuries have linked these symbols with the four aspects of our Savior as seen in the four Gospels:

Matthew— The <u>Kingly</u> aspect of Jesus — Lion Mark— The <u>Servant</u> aspect of Jesus — Ox Luke— The <u>Human</u> aspect of Jesus — Man John— The Divine aspect of Jesus— Eagle

- Non-biblical records and Numbers 2 suggest the placement of tents around four standards—Judah Lion,
 Ephriam Ox, Reuben Man and Dan Eagle.
- 3. What is the Book?
 - a. It is the Lamb's Book of Life. Revelation 13:8 and Revelation 21:27
 - b. The wicked are not in the Book of Life. Revelation 20:15
- 4. What is the opening of the book?
 - a. It is possible to have a name removed from the book of life. Revelation 3:5. This sounds like judgment.
 - b. Judgment involves the opening of books. Daniel 7:10, Revelation 20:12.
- 5. Why is it that only Jesus can open the book:?
 - a. He was the Lamb that was slain. Revelation 5:6, John 1:29, and I Peter 1:18-20.
 - b. He has seven horns—all power to save. Hebrews 7:25 and seven eyes—all knowing and understanding. Hebrews 2:16-18, Hebrews 4:15-16.
 - c. Because Jesus humbled Himself more than anyone in the universe, took the greatest risk and showed the greatest obedience—He is exalted above all.


