SERMON NOTES

"Christ In Us The Hope Of Glory" Colossians 1:26-29

How to have Christ in us?

- Take Jesus into our body by consuming His body and blood in the communion service – Matthew 26:26-28.
- II. Take the flesh and blood of Jesus into our body by consuming His word—John 6:51-63 and II Peter 1:4.
- III. Have the mind of Jesus in us through the surrender of our independent will to His will—Philippians 2:5-8.
 - 1. Christ surrenders His will to His Father—Matthew 26:39.
 - 2. Christ is never independent from His Father—John 5:19, 30 and John 8:28.
 - 3. The only time Christ was ever separated from His Father was on the cross. This separation caused His death—Matthew 27:46-50.
 - 4. Christ is our life—Colossians 3:3,4

"Now, while our great High Priest is making the atonement for us, we should seek to become perfect in Christ. Not even by a thought could our Saviour be brought to yield to the power of temptation. Satan finds in human hearts some point where he can gain a foothold; some sinful desire is cherished, by means of which his temptations assert their power. But Christ declared of Himself." 
