- 1) Finding Fault with God’s Friends. **Verse 1**
 - **Acts 10:34&35** God looks at people and nations differently than we do.

- 2) Finding Fault with the Way God Works. **Verse 11**
 - **Isaiah 55:8&9** God’s thoughts and ways are different from ours.

- 3) Finding Fault with the Way God Heals. **Verses 12-14**
 - Pride almost kept Naaman from being healed.
Pride can keep us from receiving great blessings.
 - Naaman by faith dipped in the Jordan as instructed and is mentioned by Jesus in **Luke 4:27**.

- 4) Finding Fault with Elisha Being So Impractical. **Verses 15&16**
 - Why couldn’t Elisha take the gifts?
Because the credit was to go to _____.

- 5) Finding Fault with Elisha/God’s Patience with a New Follower of the True God. **Verse 17**
 - **2 Peter 3:9&15** We owe our salvation to God’s patience with us.

- 6) Finding Fault with Elisha/God’s Tolerance toward Someone’s Behavior. **Verses 18&19**
 - **1 Samuel 16:7** Man looks on the outward appearance, but God looks on the heart.
